II. Approval of Minutes from August Exec Board & Email Minutes

III. School Report

- 1. Turf started, estimated at 4-6 weeks. Recess rotation being made by the teachers. School is purchasing wagons so teachers don't have to carry equipment.
- 2. Down 150 students, which means budget decreased by \$500k. Budget was allocated in March, but then the audit happened. 110 gen ed left, 78 from the audit. 10 day count just came out and that is why things are changing now. Current enrollment is still over capacity. Bustamante and Kersten reassigned. Determined by contract/seniority and the district and teacher union are involved. ESE is down as well because the county changed the feeder pattern. Fritz had saved money from the end of last year to apply to this year to cover some of the deficit (500k). There will be another student count in October and February. Audits were determined by the county of schools that were over enrollment.
- 3. Threats made at Glenridge and Maitland online, no threat to our school but leadership is taking this seriously. Officer Beary reports that one of the threats was Al generated which is becoming more common. These are difficult to trace.
- 4. Key fob question from Meri Gaston. District putting together emergency funding for badge reader funding. New keys being made for teachers for specific outside doors that have different locks.
- 5. Testing wrapping up this week. Data looks a touch higher this year than last for BOY. ELA usually starts off way higher than math, same for this year.

IV. Officer Reports

A. President, Erin Provenzale

- 1. Project updates Middle School Mural & Grants: Murals look great! 18 or 19 grants, \$10k to give. Meeting today to determine disbursement.
- 2. Teachers want iXL. District has purchased for MS math. Fritz is unable to purchase (purchase order declined by the county, twice) and would like parents to e-mail the district to advocate for its purchase. He will provide

contact info to us. There are some programs the county provides that do some similar things, but nothing at the same level as iXL. Costs \$20k for the whole school, \$6k for just math for the grades that currently want it.
